BPMC Clubman's Championship

In addition to the awards that are specific to each event members taking part in any BPMC event will score points in the BPMC Clubmans Championship. This runs throughout the year and awards are given to the first three at the December AGM. The winner and runner up receive the Castrol Rose Bowl and the Castrol-Dunlop Cup respectively and keep it for one year.

If you hold a current membership (including partners) then your entry and scoring in this championship is automatic – you need take no action. We hope that this Championship will encourage members to try as many different events as possible since it reflects both participation and achievement.

Summary of Rules

The best results from up to 10 club events you enter that entail the use of a car will count. So if, for example, you enter 12 events then your worst 2 scores will be discounted. If you enter only 8 events then those 8 scores will count. Points are awarded as follows:
5 times the No. of Starters in your class minus your Finish Position, divided by the No. of Starters in your class, plus 1.
So if you finish 3rd in a class of 8 starters then your score will be:
 $5 \times (8 - 3) \text{ divided by } 8 \text{ then plus } 1 = 4.125$.

Note that the first signed-on passenger will also score on Navigation Events and Treasure Hunts, so if you have a crew of 3 or more then make sure someone doesn't get caught out!

Note also that positions will only be credited to those who have organised or marshalled on an event to ensure a more rounded involvement. Regarding organisers, a maximum of two can count for Treasure Hunts and three for Navigational exercises. Don't forget to 'sign-on' at an event to get your qualifying tick!

BPMC Marshall's Championship

BPMC feels it is important to recognise those who support the club in ways other than competing in events. Members who help with the organising of events or marshalling at them will score points in the BPMC Marshall's Championship. This runs throughout the year and an award is given to the highest scorer at the December AGM; more awards may be made at the Committee's discretion.

If you hold a current membership (including partners) then your entry and scoring in this championship is automatic – you need take no action. We hope that this Championship will encourage members to be fully involved in all aspects of the club events calendar and recognise achievement other than driving.

Summary of Rules

2 points are awarded to a competitive or non-competitive event organiser for events agreed as qualifying by the committee. A maximum of 2 organisers on Treasure Hunts and 3 on Navigation Exercises and Navigation Scatters is permitted. 1 point is awarded to a Marshall and 1 point is awarded to those setting out Sprint courses the day before. A Clerk of the Course, Secretary, Assistant Clerk, Entries Secretary, and Chief Marshall are automatically deemed to be "organisers".

Organisers of a Treasure Hunt or Navigational exercise are also awarded points in the Clubman's Championship equal to the first placed entrant in the event for one event only.
